

Regulation 417.12 (i) and (j), 416.12 (i) and (j), 418.12 (j) and (k) – Infant Formula and Feeding Instructions

For any infant (children under 18 months of age), provider must obtain a written statement from the parent describing formula and feeding instructions for the infant. If formula is required the statement must state whether the formula is prepared by the parent or the provider. If the formula is to be prepared by the provider specific instructions (amount of water and formula) must be in writing from the parent in addition to the feeding schedule. Parents must also give written permission for the provider to prepare the formula. Parents must also describe solid foods child is eating and how they are to be prepared.
